Food & Drink Policy

In general water is the only food or drink item allowed in class. Some situations will allow food but it is contingent on it not becoming a distraction in class, and as long as students can handle the responsibility. This policy is subject to change at my discretion, and at any time.



Assignments & Rubrics

All typed assignments, for the most part, are completed in class. I will give students plenty of time to complete the tasks. Once an assignment is complete, students will receive a stamp. After the tasks in each standard are complete or the due date has passed, assignments will be graded based on completion.

There are a few assignments that will require work at home but there is also plenty of time given and will never be an overnight homework assignment.

Student rubrics will be kept in a bin in my classroom and should not be taken home. Each student will have a folder with their rubrics inside.

At the beginning of each unit, students will set goals for their work and be given a missing task log.

Part of our curriculum is goal setting and responsibility and students are ALWAYS in control of their assignments and work.

All work will be posted to an online portfolio that is easily accessible to parents. Please contact me for more information.



Policy for Absences and Grades

Each unit is broken down into standards. From there assignments are created with different point values based difficulty and length of assignment. As students turn in completed and correct work they earn stamps.

Once all stamps for a standard are done they will receive their grade. However, if they do not complete the work during the assigned time they will lose points based off what they are missing.

Make up work will be accepted, however, if they student was given time in class and they chose not to complete their work, points will be removed.

If a student is absent, this system is very easy for them to come back and see exactly what they missed and get the work done and turned in.

I am always available during Flight School to assist students who need extra help.



Electronic Devices

Electronic devices will only be used in class with the direction of the teacher for educational purposes. Please have the following apps downloaded to your child's device when they come to class, others may be needed during the semester.
